

## Medicaid

- Reservations must be made two days, and up to seven days in advance.
- It is only for services that are MEDICALLY NECESSARY and are COVERED BY MEDICAL ASSISTANCE.

In order to be eligible for Medicaid coverage of your transportation:

- You must be a resident of Anne Arundel County
- You MUST have Full Medical Assistance/Health Choice coverage and have an active Medical Assistance (MA) number.
  - Specified Low Income Medicare Beneficiary (SLMB) and Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB) are NOT ELIGIBLE for the program.
- You must not have any other way to get to the appointment you are requesting transportation for. This transportation can only be used as a LAST RESORT.

## Medicare

Call 1-800-633-4227 for detailed coverage information.

- **Only Medicare Part C (Medicare Advantage) may include non-emergency transportation.**
  - Check with your specific Medicare Advantage plan to see if it offers non-emergency transport.
- Medicare Part A and Medicare Part B **do not** cover non-emergency transportation
- With a written certification from the doctor, Medicare Part B patients may be eligible to receive transportation from home and back.
- ***THERE IS NO GUARANTEE YOU WILL RECEIVE TRANSPORTATION COVERAGE.***
- ***If you do not book your transportation through your Medicare Advantage plan, you cannot be reimbursed for this cost!***

- Reservations must be made two days, and up to seven days in advance



To be eligible you must be:

- A resident of Anne Arundel County
- 18 and older with a disability (Acceptable Documentation and/or SSI award letter)
- Or 55 and older

- Can be billed to insurance if covered or out of pocket
- Zone 1 20 mile radius of Baltimore
  - \$22.95 + \$2.10 per mile
- Zone 2 20-30 mile radius from Baltimore
  - \$26.95 + \$2.10 per mile
- Zone 3 30-45 mile radius from Baltimore
  - \$34.45 + \$2.10 per mile
- Zone 4 45-70 mile radius from Baltimore
  - \$46.95 + \$2.10 per mile
